At some point in life, many of us have lived, or know someone who has lived paycheck to paycheck. One misfortune can send financial stability into a tailspin. A car breakdown, an illness, or loss of job can be a turning point. East Mountain Womenade was designed to help local families with school-aged children endure these hard times. With a tried and true screening process, working through school counselors and social workers, families are provided with financial assistance via gas cards, cards for groceries and/or clothing, or bills paid directly to utility and mortgage companies or simply purchasing firewood so families aren't without heat.

Founded in 2002, the first EM Womenade Potluck was held and eleven years later, due to the consistent support from local residents, the organization is approaching \$100,000 in assistance distributed to needy families. Counselors and social workers repeatedly express their appreciation for the uncomplicated and timely process of acquiring aid from EM Womenade to help families who suddenly find themselves in dire straits. One hundred percent of contributions go to families in need and are tax deductible.
